IN ADDITION, THE UNDERSIGNED AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS the "releasees" negligence or otherwise while the undersigned is participation at this event. In signing the release, each of the undersigned hereby acknowledges and represents the following: 1. 2017 WARSAW YOUTH BASEBALL RULES & GUIDELINES

GUIDELINES:

8-9-10 YEAR OLDS-

- Age cutoff is May 1st. 8year old players may choose to participate in the machine pitch parks and recreation program, depending on skill level.
- Pitching distance will be 46'
- Base distance will be 65'
- NO metal cleats!!!
- NO drop 3rd strike
- 7 run rule per inning

11-12 YEAR OLDS-

- Age cutoff is May 1st. Some 13 year olds maybe accepted into the league based on their DOB and skill level. Any 13 year old requesting to play will have to provide proof of age.
- Pitching distance 50'
- Base distance 70'
- Games will be held at Poe field (Bledsoe Ferry) unless an overflow is needed. In that case this age group will play @ Lumpe Field and it will be noted on the schedule.
- NO metal cleats!!
- 7 run rule per inning

RULES

- Players can only be on 1 roster. If you are short a player and need to make arrangements to borrow a player please notify WPR @ 660-438-2312
- All bats must be permanently stamped with the new USSSA 1.15BPF mark or BBCOR 50 certified mark.
- Umpires may inspect bats at their discretion. If an umpire feels a bat presents a safety hazard or the bat is broken he/she may remove the bat from play.
- Run Rule 8 after 4 or 15 after 3
- NO intentional walks
- Runner must slide if there is a play at the base (other than 1st base)-umpires discretion
- Any pitch count violations must be reported to the umpire immediately
- A game can end in a tie if time has expired.
- A game is 6 innings or 1 1/2 hour time limit.

PITCH COUNTS

- 1 PITCH AN INNING COUNTS AS AN INNING PITCHED
- 7 INNINGS OR MAX 90 PITCHES PER WEEK- MON-SUN
- IF A PITCHER THROWS 5 INNINGS IN A GAME HE MUST REST 3 DAYS
 - 40 PITCHES OR MORE-NO CATCHING
 - IF CATCHING MORE THAN 3 INNINGS-NO PITCHING

Example: Pitcher throws 4 innings on Monday, he throws 1 inning on Wednesday, he can still throw 2 innings on Friday. Come Monday it is a new week so he starts over with 7 innings.

Example: Pitcher throws 5 innngs on Monday, he must rest for Wednesdays game, but can still pitch 2 innings on Friday.

Example: Pitcher throws 2 innings on Monday or Wednesday and 5 innings on Friday. He must rest on Monday and is not available to pitch until Tuesday.

2017 WARSAW YOUTH BASEBALL RULES & GUIDELINES

- Fee is \$30 per child
- Each child must have a registration form and waiver on file with the Warsaw Parks & Recreation Department before he/she can play
- Sponsor fee is \$200 (shirts, hats, and awards will be provided for this fee)
- If your team provides their own shirts and hats the sponsor fee is \$50
- All fees are due at the time of registration
- If you are registering as a full team all payment will need to be made at one time. It can be multiple checks made out to the City of Warsaw but all registrations and waivers will need to be present at one time along with payment. (in person or mail is fine)
- A photographer will take photos at the beginning of the season. Each player is responsible for placing and paying for their own order. There will be a schedule sent with the season schedule for photos. If this time does not work for your team the coach will be responsible for rescheduling the time and notifying WPR that they will not be participating in photos.
- Each full team that registers MUST provide their own sponsor. WPR will assist in securing sponsors for teams that are formed based on individual registrations
- Games will be held at Bledsoe Ferry Sports Complex unless otherwise noted on the schedule.
- Each team will play 8-12 games based on number of teams registered
- Double headers are available for out of town teams. If you would like to request double headers please make a note on your registration for or contact Susan @ 660-438-5522.
- There will be a single elimination tournament at the end of the season. Seeding will be based on win/loss record and the final league standings will be based on the tournament results!!
- Awards will be given
- Each team will be responsible for keeping score, as well as their own pitch count. The home team on the schedule will be responsible for the “home” book for that game.
- Each team must report each pitchers name and pitch count/innings to the umpire after each game. This information must also be available to the umpire at any time he asks.
- Concessions will be available
- Umpires are provided
- USSSA rules with the above listed exceptions
