

The City Of Warsaw is accepting bids for **material** to construct a 100' long approximately 750 SF retaining wall at the amphitheater and a paved boarder along Steamboat Landing Boardwalk.

The retaining wall material will be a 3 piece combination Highland Stone Maize with the dimensions of:

12" x 6" x 6"

12" x 6" x 12"

12" x 6" x 18"

The pattern will run horizontal and include a cap.

The wall system must match the color, texture and design of the current wall system in the Drake Harbor Recreation Area. A drawing and aerial map that details current wall locations is available upon request for bid information.

The paved area will be 1260' by 1.5 feet wide. The material will be Holland Stone Slate Ledges, Rock Century Mountain and Grey Pave Edge Flexible.
