#10: The Composing Stone (109 Main Street)

This "Composing Stone" is from the office of the Benton County Enterprise, started by the Thomas Benton White Family in 1879. The paper was housed in a combination 1840 log cabin and a part of the steamboat the River Queen. The building was both an office for the newspaper and home for the family until 1930 when the newspaper office moved to south Main Street. Later, it moved back into the "Log Cabin" where it remained until the present quarters were erected in the 1970's.
