#18: Riverside Cemetery (Jackson Street)

Riverside Cemetery is a beautiful cemetery sitting high atop the bluffs of the Osage.

Judge James Lay is buried here and has a beautiful monument. Be sure and check out the gravestones of Doc and Rita Porter and Mrs. Porter's "Rules of Living".

The first person buried here was Alfred William Lay, son of the late Judge James A Lay, in 1904.
