

**CITY OF WARSAW
PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

The City of Warsaw will hold a public hearing on Monday April 25th, 2022, from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at the Warsaw Community Building, lower level located at 181 W. Harrison St. to discuss the city's planned "Complete Streets" improvements for the Main Street corridor, from the intersection at State Street to U.S. 65 Highway. Prior to the roadway improvements, the city has been replacing the old sewer and waterlines. Construction will begin this summer to complete the replacement of waterlines in this corridor.

The city is currently preparing the preliminary design for the next phase of Main Street improvements, which include adding bike lanes, storm sewers, sidewalks and lighting along the north side of the roadway between Hackberry and Gunstock Drive. This project is funded through a Community Development Block Grant. The city is interested in obtaining citizens' input on this phase, as well as future phases of the Main Street corridor improvements. Future phases of the Main Street Complete Streets improvements will be developed as funding is acquired.

All citizens are encouraged to attend in order to comment on the proposed improvements.
