

The City of Warsaw is Requesting Qualifications (RFQ's). The RFQ's is for engineers to redesign the Steamboat Landing Boardwalk. The current boardwalk is in need of replacement and raised one foot.

Due to elevated and prolonged flooding, the boardwalk structure was subjected to submersion and the City began noticing increasing "soft-spots" along the length of the boardwalk which was believed to be failure of the supporting treated lumber framing. Also velocities from the flood waters, specifically along the south end of the boardwalk levee, were believed to have caused loss of slope protection supporting the trail slopes.

Existing Structure:

The boardwalk construction consists of a typical 10' wide x 1,055' long platform of composite decking on treated 2x8 framing. The framing bears on a treated sill plate resting on a concrete footing on the upper side and another sill on modular concrete block wall on the lower side. Gravel was used to fill between the two foundation elements allowing for only 2"-3" of space below the framing members.

New structure:

The boardwalk redesign will be a steel structure with a composite deck. The current railing will be removed and reinstalled. An inspection report was completed April 1st, 2020 and is available by pdf for review.

It is required that your firm's Statement of Qualification (RSMo 8.285 through 8.291) and an Affidavit of Compliance with the federal work authorization program along with a copy of your firm's E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding (15 CSR 60-15.020) be submitted with your firm's Letter of Interest.
