

INVITATION TO BID CITY OF WARSAW

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Warsaw, Missouri at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 201 West Harrison, P.O. Box 68, Warsaw, Missouri 65355 **until 2:00 P.M, January 8th, 2025**, on capital improvement projects described in general as “Commercial Street and Polk Street Roadway and Sidewalk Improvements, in the City of Warsaw, Missouri”.

The proposed work includes: Grading and Embankment, 6” Subgrade Compaction, Demolition and Removal of Pavement, Curbing and Drainage Structures, Concrete Pavement, a Concrete Shoulder, Sidewalks and Curb Ramps, Concrete Driveways, Asphaltic Pavement Widening and Milling and Overlay, Aggregate Base, Asphalt Microsurfacing, Curb and Gutter, Storm Sewers, Curb Inlets, Pavement Markings, a Pedestrian Crossing System, Temporary Erosion Control, Temporary Traffic Control, Seed and Mulch and Signage.

Proposed Bidding Documents may be examined at Warsaw City Hall at 201 W. Main Street, Warsaw MO.

The wage rates applicable to this project have been predetermined as required by law and are set forth in this appendices. Annual Wage Order #31, State Prevailing Wage Rates apply.

The City of Warsaw hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Bid Security will be required in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bidder qualifications may be required in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope marked “Bid for Commercial Street and Polk Street TDD Improvements in the City of Warsaw, Missouri.” Bids received after the designated closing time will be returned unopened.

CONTRACTOR SHOULD READ AND BE FULLY FAMILIAR WITH ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS BEFORE SUBMITTING A BID. IN SUBMITTING A BID, THE BIDDER WARRANTS THAT IT HAS READ THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND IS FULLY FAMILIAR THEREWITH AND THAT IT HAS VISITED THE SITE OF THE WORK TO FULLY INFORM ITSELF AS TO ALL EXISTING CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS AND SHALL INCLUDE IN ITS BID A SUM TO COVER THE COST OF ALL ITEMS OF THE WORK.

Should a bidder find “defects”; it shall bring such “defects” to the attention of City. Changes necessitated thereby shall be in the form of addenda issued by the Consulting Engineer.

All bidders shall verify that they have considered all written addenda. Neither the City nor the Consulting Engineer shall be responsible for oral instructions. Any written addenda issued during the time of bidding shall be covered and included in the bid. There will be no clarifications or exceptions allowed on the Bid. Bids are for a total bid package, total contract price.

The City of Warsaw, Missouri, reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids and to waive any technicalities or irregularities therein. Bids may be modified or withdrawn by written request of the bidder received in the office of the City Clerk, prior to the time and date for bid opening; provided, however, that no bidder may withdraw its bid for a period of thirty (60) days from the date set for the opening thereof. ALL BIDDERS AGREE THAT REJECTION SHALL CREATE NO LIABILITY ON THE PART OF THE CITY BECAUSE OF SUCH REJECTION, AND THE FILING OF ANY BID IN RESPONSE TO THIS

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
